The State Auditor of Public Accounts (APA) has completed the Education Jobs Fund (Ed Jobs) monitoring for the Kentucky Department of Education to fulfill the monitoring requirements of the United States Department of Education for this grant. The purpose of the monitoring was to ensure that the district is complying with the federal regulations, reporting requirements and to determine if adequate controls exist to monitor spending of the funds.

As a reminder, Education Jobs Fund is a new federal program that provides assistance to States to save or create education jobs at the school level. Jobs funded under this program include those that provide educational and related services for early childhood, elementary and secondary education.

The APA found Spencer County to be in compliance with the guidelines set forth in administering the Ed Jobs grant. Please continue to be successful in providing oversight of the grant.
