8	STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 156.029, 156.070, 158.6453, 158.6455
9	NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: This is to repeal 703 KAR 5:120,
10	Assistance for schools; guidelines for scholastic audit. This administrative regulation, which was
11	last revised in 2004 and was designed to implement the Commonwealth Accountability Testing
12	System (CATS), is no longer needed because the mandates in the regulation are no longer
13	consistent with current state and federal accountability requirements. 2009 Senate Bill 1 amended
14	KRS 158.6455 to delete references to CATS, and required revision of the state accountability
15	system using the new assessments mandated by SB 1. This regulation, which requires
16	identification of schools as Level 1, 2, and 3 based on an index score that places the school below
17	the assistance line, and performing either a scholastic audit or scholastic review based upon this
18	identification, implements the CATS accountability system and does not reflect the requirements
19	of Kentucky's Unbridled Learning: College and Career Readiness for All accountability system
