To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of the Sheldon Clark High School student athletes, I am requesting that our football program be granted a move from Class 3A to Class 2A for the 2015-2018 Kentucky Football Alignment. I am requesting this move for the following reasons:

- From the 2010-2011 school year until February 5, 2014, our boys' enrollment has dropped from 361 to 288 (a 20.2% decrease in boys enrollment over 4 years).
- From the 2012-2013 school year until February 5, 2014, our boys' enrollment has dropped from 336 to 288 (a 14.3% decrease in boys enrollment over 2 years).
- The SCHS football team finished with 22 players on the roster. Five of those players were injured and unable to play, which means we played our last game with only 17 football players dressed.
- Seven of our players are questionable for next year due to their fathers losing their jobs in the coal industry.
- Only 4 eighth grade students played on our middle school feeder team.
- Although we cannot predict the actual enrollment for next year, there is a strong
 possibility that our boys enrollment will decrease dramatically each year for the
 foreseeable future due to the decline in the coal industry and our school facilities
 situation (specifically, losing the old Sheldon Clark High School building due to
 road construction).

These low numbers force our student-athletes to play offense, defense, and special teams against schools whose numbers afford them the luxury of having multiple players at different positions. Even though anyone can get injured at anytime, this increases the possibility for injury for our student athletes due to the number of plays and fatigue. Each team in our district dressed at least twice as many student-athletes, with two schools dressing nearly three times our numbers. Schools at the 2A level face the same issues that the students of Sheldon Clark face. (Although we played two Class 2A schools that dressed double the student athletes that we did.)

In short, our boys enrollment history provides justification for the move to Class 2A. More importantly, our numbers on the football field makes our players more

susceptible to injury. Based on these two factors, I am asking that Sheldon Clark High School be placed in the Class 2A system for the 2015-2018 Kentucky Football Alignment.
