^{*}An additional \$16,250 per year is the amount reflected when adding to the current extra-service stipends. The justification for restructuring heavily in the athletic areas is primarily due to the discrepancy with surrounding OVEC district averages. Many of our current club stipends are near or have surpassed surrounding districts already, however, even with the passage of this proposal our athletic programs are still behind. If we want to address only the areas that have been mentioned by the addition of newly requested clubs and sports, as well as increase the AD salaries of both schools because of the increased job responsibilities, we would only be increasing the overall stipend list by approximately \$7,500 rather than \$16,250, however, one of the major concerns that both AD's haveexpressed is that one of their most difficult tasks is retaining coaches because of low pay. Hopefully, moving many of the supplements closer to the OVEC average will result in better retention of our coaching staff and less turnover within athletics.
