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# **Updates to TC Forms**

The Education Professional Standards Board (EPSB) is beginning the "phase-out" process of the TC or "Teacher Certification" application forms for the CA or "Certification Application" forms. The impetus for the new forms was the EPSB's adoption last fall of a new character and fitness questionnaire and a new criminal background requirement for newly certified educators. At the March 17, 2014, board meeting, the EPSB adopted the new CA-1, CA-2, and CA-HQ forms along with the necessary regulatory amendments needed to implement the use of the new forms. The regulations associated with the forms, 16 KAR 2:010 and 16 KAR 4:060, were filed this month and will be posted for public comment on the Legislative Research

Commission's website in May. Assuming there are no comments, the EPSB anticipates the regulatory amendments will become effective in early August with required use as of January 1, 2015.

## **Background Checks**

As of January 1, 2015, changes to 16 KAR 2:010 will require individuals seeking initial certification, not a rank change or renewal, to submit a criminal background check with their application. The criminal background check required is the same background check required by school districts for student teachers. If the applicant student taught in Kentucky, the applicant needs to request a copy of the state and federal criminal background check from the school and submit it to the EPSB.

Applicants who did not student teach in Kentucky or who are seeking certification from out of state will have to request that a criminal background check from the Kentucky State Police and the Federal Bureau of Investigation be sent directly to the EPSB. ### **Cooperating Teacher and University Supervisor Training**

As outlined in 16 KAR 5:040, cooperating teachers and university supervisors must complete three types of training: Part A, the basic responsibilities associated with the role; Part B, best practice in supporting the student teacher; and Part C, effective assessment of the student teacher. EPPs who are planning fall student teaching assignments should verify that teachers who are expected to serve as cooperating teachers have completed these trainings. ### **Cooperating Teacher Stipends**

The EPSB provides a stipend to cooperating teachers who guide student teachers in their classrooms. Funds will be sent to districts in May, and cooperating teachers may expect payment on a June paycheck. Although these stipends are modest, cooperating teachers perform an important and valued function in the preparation of Kentucky's teachers. We want to thank our teachers for their expertise and valuable time to support our aspiring teachers.

## **KTIP Resource Teacher Payments and Final Reports**

KTIP resource teachers should be submitting spring or full-year time sheets through the Intern Management System once all cycle committee meetings have been completed. EPSB staff have already begun submitting payments to those teachers who have submitted accurate documentation. The resource teacher time sheets require separate signatures from the Record of Teacher Internship Year (RTIY). ## **Kentucky Center for Education and Workforce Statistics**

The Center just added a new section to their website that contains public access data files. The data files are provided in Excel workbooks. Each includes a tab with summary level data for all high schools and all counties in Kentucky with the same information one can find in the 2013 Kentucky High School Feedback Reports and the 2014-15 County Profile Reports.

Users can sort, query, and develop graphs and tables with the data instead of typing in information from individual reports. A data dictionary tab with technical notes is also included.
