## **BYLAW 11 CONCLUSIONS**

- Schools in red gave two sets of answers. They were either both incomplete or they gave different information
- 189 schools answered the survey
- 104 Schools reported that their school district does not charge tuition for any reason
- 40 schools reported that they waive all or part of this tuition for some reason including financial aid
- 36 schools reported that students pay less than full tuition for some reason. Most often these reasons include: financial aid, merit aid (based on test-14 reports), employee discount, multi child discount
- Not sure of the accuracy of data as some AD's and Principals attempt to answer the survey instead of turning it over to business office

## BYLAW 11 CONCLUSIONS AND FOLLOW UP

## • Follow up:

- 1 school reported that they use free and reduced applications for basis of thition reduction
- 4 other schools did not specifically that they use an approved outside agency
- 5 schools reported that the average dollar amount awarded was more for the student athlete than for the average student. 3 of these were under \$100 difference. The other two were not more than \$300 difference.
- Several private schools did not complete the survey. Inquire.
- Several public schools immediately answered no to the question about tuition. It is likely that the school does charge some type of tuition for out of area students, etc. Need to clarify or remedy.
