- JOB FUNCTION: Plan and coordinate network development and maintenance of the voice and data transmission facilities and voice and data communications equipment making up the District telecommunications network; direct and coordinate the installation, maintenance and operation of network telecommunications equipment for data and voice communications; maintain knowledge of current technology requiring modifications to the existing voice and data and communications systems.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan and coordinate the system development and maintenance of the telecommunications network. and coordinate the operations and maintenance of building networks as well as Wide Area Network facilities.
- Direct and coordinate the installation, maintenance and operations of telecommunications equipment for district and building networks.
- Assist in the selection of the most efficient equipment for network telecommunications needs and assure proper interface with equipment on the networks.
- Interface with information services personnel and maintenance technicians to determine the most efficient methods of implementing network hardware/software and to determine appropriate preventive maintenance procedures for telecommunications networking equipment.
- Implement and maintain reports and statistics that measure operating conditions of the data tele communications systems and analyze same for corrective action.
- Plan, coordinate, and administer the district's E-Rate program, receiving, processing, and evaluating information in an accurate, timely manner and providing USAC with full, correct information, while remaining current on program changes and compliance with program rules.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (CONT.):

- Provide oversight of <u>telecommunications</u> contractors performing <u>network wiring</u> install<u>ations and repair</u>s. Evaluate performance and prescribe corrective actions needing accomplishment.
- Maintain a working relationship with other District personnel regarding telecommunications technology with a view towards future enhancements to the network telecommunications system.

- Maintain knowledge of current technology requiring modifications to the existing telecommunications system and assist with training of school and office personnel.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
- Maintain regular attendance.
