BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE: The construction of a new 1,800-student high school to be located on a new site located at 1970 Winchester Road is listed as priority 1a.5 on FCPS's 2013 District Facility Plan. The building construction project will be funded through a bond issue and is subject to the approval of the Kentucky Department of Education. A BG-1 Project Application for the construction, identifying the extent and cost of the work, has been approved by the Board and has been filed with the Kentucky Department of Education. At this time, the Board is required by 702 KAR 4:160 to indicate acceptance of the design development documents represented in the plans prepared by the design consultants Tate Hill Jacobs Architects. Based on the review of these documents by FCPS staff, the Department of Physical Support Services recommends approval of these plans. Upon the Board's approval, these documents will be submitted to the KDE District Facilities Branch for review and approval prior to the preparation of construction documents.
