This data represents the numbers of completed reviews. A complete survey had reviewers look at every standard in a given arts discipline. Some Surveys offered the option for reviewers to consider:

- Is the standard clear?
- Is the standard grade/level appropriate?
- Is the standard achievable?
- Is the standard measurable?
- Is the standard aligned to Anchor Standards?

Reviewers were given the option of adding a narrative comment for each standard. The resulting feedback amounted to over one million comments and suggestions for writers to consider. Researchers helped to compile and synthesize the data prior each edit.


