## APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED CHANGE ORDER (NO. THIRTEEN) and CORRECTION TO PREVIOUS AGENDA ITEM (RE: CHANGE ORDER NO. TWO) TO THE CONTRACT FOR THE RENOVATION AT TATES CREEK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BG 11-251

**BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:** The renovation of the existing Tates Creek Elementary School is listed as priority 2c.4 on FCPS's 2009 District Facility Plan. GBBN Architects has produced Construction Documents (plans, specifications, bidding requirements, etc.) describing a renovation of the existing building and the construction of an addition totaling approximately 79,087 SF to serve 750 students, based upon FCPS elementary school program standards. Bids were received on May 17, 2012 and construction began in July, 2012. The Department of Physical Support Services, the design consultants and the local building code officials have reviewed the progress of the work. Changes to the original plans and specifications have been necessary in order to satisfy the requirements described below. Approval of these changes allows the work to be completed.
