- If a student is ruled ineligible based on this submission, practice and play at the non-varsity level or practice with the varsity team are at the discretion of the member school once that ruling is received.
- The KHSAA member school shall ensure that all parts of this form are complete and legible, and all required attachments are included.
- The form will be reviewed by the Commissioner's office and a ruling will be issued.
- 10. For processing, allow a minimum three (3) working days to ensure time for verification of the data and be mindful that in accordance with the Due Process Procedure, the Ruling Officer has thirty (30) days to rule, and additional time if investigation is necessary.
- 11. Only the Principal and/or Designated Representative of a member school may inquire as to the processing status of the form.
- 12. The waiver of Bylaw 7 does not in and of itself declare the student eligible. It is the responsibility of the member school to verify that the student is eligible according to all other bylaws.
- 13. No verbal statement in addition or in contradiction to these materials shall apply.
- 14. If an aggrieved party is dissatisfied with the decision; an appeal may be taken in the manner set forth in the KHSAA Due Process Procedure
