










GARETAKING SYSTEMS SCHOOL SAFETY STRATEGIC ACTION PLAN





School Safety Strategic Plan:

Goal: NC Schools will share a School Safety Strategic Plan, focusing on three priority areas (Safety Protocols, Student Connectedness and First Responder Partnerships) by August 2019.

Action Steps

- 1) By September 2018, NC Schools will facilitate quarterly community safety forums with Emergency Management Services.
- 2) By December 2018, NC Schools will select members of a School Safety Strategic Planning Team.
- 3) By February 2019, NC Schools will facilitate quarterly Student Safety Teams.
- 4) By May 2019, NC Schools will identify priorities for the three identified priority areas identified within the District Safety Strategic Plan.
- 5) By June 2019, NC Schools will present a District Safety Strategic Plan to the Board of Education for 1st read, with planned implementation beginning August 2019.

PHYSICAL HEALTH & WELLNESS









- 1) **PRIDE:** NC Schools are being served by nine school nurses.
- 2) **SHARED LEADERSHIP:** Nelson County is in their first contracted year with Cumberland Family Medical, who provides all supplies and a nurse practitioner/provider nurse to CARE for students and staff through sick visits and well-child CARE.
- 3) **SHARED LEADERSHIP:** 30% of our nurses' salaries is being brought back to the district through our partnership with Cumberland Family Medical.
- 4) **PRIDE:** School nurses are serving on average 15 students per day. Over the last three months the nurse practitioner has seen 547 students for sick visits and 234 for well-child visits. They also administered 720 flu vaccines.



Action Steps:

- 1. NC Schools will create a CARE book for all Food Services Employees for 2019-20.
- 2. NC Schools will host a Food Services Caretaking Camp in August 2019.
- 3. NC Schools will continue to build CAFE CARE through designated Backpack days in 2019-20.

Healthy Food Experiences Goal: NC Schools will reimagine possibilities with positive food-related experiences for students, staff and community members.

Action Steps:

- 1. NC Schools will plan seasonal menus, creating opportunities for students to try different fruits and vegetables for 2019-20.
- 2. NC Schools will create a recipe catalog for menu options that allows cafes to use more fresh ingredients beginning August 2019.
- 3. NC Schools will establish a Junior Chef team for 2019-2020.











CARETAKING SYSTEMS NUTRITION GOALS





Community Centered Cafes Goal: NC Schools will offer healthier, fresh and local food options through The National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program beginning August 2019.

Action Steps:

- 1. NC Schools will allocate additional funds to the USDA Department of Defense (DoD) Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program for 2019-20.
- 2. NC Schools will pursue a Farm to School Grant Program during 2019-20.
- 3. NC Schools will begin researching implementation of student operated school gardens for 2019-20.


