- A dedicated media strategy website;
- Public Relations Toolkits and Webinars;
- Guidelines for a Successful Publicity Strategy
- Writing the News and Working with the Media
- Setting Goals and Measuring Success
- Material Templates
- Creating a Media Strategy to Harness the Power of Publicity
- A revised State Policy Database (Athletic Eligibility, Immunizations, State Registration);
