From gaming to jump scares, summertime in downtown Indianapolis means weekends that are jam packed with conventions and celebrations centered




It also means lots of foot traffic on Georgia Street, and longer than usual lines at the Circle Center Mall Food Court.

June 28 - July 6


USA Volleyball Association Girl's Jr. National Championship




