2020 KDE Management Audit

Visit

During the three-week review (Sept 21-Oct 9), KDE conducted 1558 interviews.

KDE also reviewed hundreds of documents of evidence, personnel records, educational records of our early childhood students and students with disabilities, and inspected buses.

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Findings

There is **not** a pattern of a significant lack of efficiency and effectiveness in the governance and administration of JCPS

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Findings

Neither state management nor state assistance is necessary

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Findings

The Settlement Agreement should be
considered fulfilled

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Significant Improvements

- Career and Technical Education (CTE)
- Finance
- Professional Development Opportunities

Improvement Areas

- Special Education
- Safe Crisis Management

KDE Recommendations for Improvement

- Continue to implement a progress monitoring system to close achievement gaps
- Develop a process for additional quality control checks
- Engage in ongoing, individualized professional learning
- Establish goal for improving number of behavior referrals
- Continue to pursue opportunities to generate adequate revenues
- Seek, identify, and communicate connections between initiatives

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Next Steps

- Review the findings and recommendations in the report and incorporate into JCPS improvement practices and routines
- Collaborate with KDE to ensure JCPS meets expectations under the Individual with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)

Continuous Improvement Systems –

Cabinet Reviews (42 CAP items)

- Focuses on high risk/high impact strategies
- Supports cross department collaborations
- Provides opportunity for feedback and course corrections

Monitoring Reports (28 CAP items)

- Aligns with District Master Calendar routine
- Ensures that CAP monitoring systems continue
- Allows for expansion beyond CAP items
- Follow up on unresponsive actions for accountability
- Serves as a succession planning resource
