Students living within the Choice Zone (black outline) can attend a school close to home or a designated school farther away.

Incoming kindergarten, sixth-, and ninth-grade students; students new to Jefferson County Public Schools (JCPS); or students with an address change in the Choice Zone must complete an application to make their close-to-home or far-away school selection. There is no default school. Students can update their selection annually.

All students may also apply for magnets and transfers.

- 2024-2025 Application Period:November 6th-December 22nd
- Comprehensive School Choice Outreach Strategy

   Targeted outreach in the Choice Zone (transition nights at schools, daycares, and community based events)
- Incoming kindergarten, 6th, and 9th grade students living in the Choice Zone are required to complete an application and rank school selections inside the Choice Zone or outside of the Choice Zone. Students will not be defaulted to their close-to-home or far-away option.
