


### Enrollment

Enrollment at Newport Independent Schools on January 19, 2024 was 1428. This is a ten student increase over prior month. Four additional students are pending enrollment.



As of January 19, 2024 our five low attendance days include January 16th, January 17th, December 20th, December 1st, and November 1st. January 19, 2024 is our first Non-Traditional Instruction day for the 2023-2024 school year. Nine days remain for weather and health circumstances.

The 2023-2024 school calendar includes 172 instructional days (170 is required) and 186 total school days (teacher contract required). We have 1127 total hours in all calendars with 65 banked hours.

#### Title III

The state assessment window for English Language Learners is currently open through February 16, 2024. To meet Title III requirements, schools are mandated to identify and annually administer a standards-based English language proficiency test to all English Language Learners (ELLs) in grades K-12. This data is reported through the school report card. Each school has an assigned Building Assessment Coordinator (BAC) that works with our District Assessment Coordinator(DAC) to schedule and oversee assessments within their school. Our most recent published scores are included below. Newport High School, School of Innovation, and Newport Regional School data have restricted data. Newport Independent is currently providing services to over 200 students through the English Language Learners and Newcomers programs.
