# IV. SCOPE OF WORK

Elements of all Chemours school partnerships will include financial support for things such as STEM learning activities, lab equipment, and/or other needed resources. Chemours will also offer nonfinancial support to the school(s) identified above, including some or all of the following:

- STEM Team Afterschool Club team focused on exposing various branches of STEM in diverse learning capacities

- Future of Chemistry grants for students to attend STEM-based summer programs or structured learning opportunities. (This fund would be established by Chemours with an initial contribution, which would be the anchor element of the partnership and allow the school to access funding for different STEM-related programs.)
- School Community & STEM Focused Activities
  - o Field Day Activities
  - Science Fair
  - o Staff vs. Student Dodge Ball Game
  - o STEM Showcase
  - o STEM Days / Workshops (fall, winter, spring, and summer)

- Career Day/STEM Facilitator Engagements
  - o Mentoring
  - o Job Shadowing
  - o Classroom Guest Speakers
- Sponsor/Chaperone assistance on STEM focused field trips as appropriate
- Outdoor Classroom / Environmental Club
- Chemours Banner for Farnsley Middle School Football Field
- Farnsley Middle School grounds cleanup around walking track
- Science Project mentoring
- Science lab inventory review by Chemours employees of materials and equipment
- Material (print and/or digital) for supplemental learning activities

Require the following, pursuant to KRS 160.380, for all contractors, employees, interns and volunteers under this agreement:

- 1. A state criminal record check;
- 2. A state and national criminal (fingerprint) history background check; AND
- 3. A letter, provided by the individual, from the Cabinet for Health and Family Services stating that there are no findings of substantiated child abuse or neglect on record.

No contractor, employee, intern or volunteer shall be utilized to supervise students, or deemed to have the authority to supervise students, unless the volunteer has been designated to supervise students by the Principal and approved by the Superintendent/designee, and the volunteer has undergone the required records check.

Prohibit contractors, employees, interns and volunteers under this agreement from performing services under this agreement and from remaining upon the premises of a JCPS facility for any purpose under this Agreement if the contractor, employee, intern or volunteer has been convicted of the following:

- 1. Any conviction for sex-related offenses:
- 2. Any conviction for offenses against minors;
- 3. Any conviction for felony offenses except as provided in number 5 below;
- 4. Any conviction for deadly weapon-related offenses;
- 5. Any conviction for drug-related offenses, including felony drug offenses, within the past seven (7) years;
- 6. Any conviction for violent, abusive, threatening or harassment related offenses; OR

7. Other convictions determined by the Superintendent/designee to bear a reasonable relationship to the ability of the applicant to serve as a volunteer.

Contractors, employees, interns and volunteers under this Agreement shall immediately notify the school Principal or the Volunteer Talent Center if they are convicted of or plead guilty to one of the criminal offenses listed above and shall immediately cease providing services under this Agreement and shall not remain upon premises of a JCPS facility for any purpose under this Agreement.

# V. <u>SCHOOL DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITIES</u>

- 1. Facility Jefferson County Public School District is to provide suitable classroom, including laboratory space at the participating School(s), to be agreed upon by Jefferson County Public School District and Farnsley Middle School, for use by Farnsley Middle School to conduct on-site portions of Scope of Work.
- 2. Janitorial Service *Jefferson County Public School District* shall provide necessary services to maintain the aforesaid classroom and laboratory space, including janitorial services, maintenance, utilities, and technology support.
  - 3. Coordination *Jefferson County Public School District* shall provide a liaison or contact person at the school-level to assist *Farnsley Middle School* with coordination and implementation of on-site Scope of Work at school(s).
  - 4. Promotional Activities Jefferson County Public School District shall co-promote with Farnsley Middle School on media and social media program events such as National Chemistry Week; National Engineers Week; Women's History Month; and Science/Math Fairs. Jefferson County Public School District shall also actively engage with Chemours leadership team within the school community (e.g., Principal for a Day").
  - 5. Co-branding Jefferson County Public School District shall acknowledge and promote partnership with Farnsley Middle School both internally within school(s) above (i.e., Chemours-branded building signage) Any co-branding assets will be designed in collaboration with JCPS Communication and Community Relations Department. JCPS reserves the right to remove any Chemours branded signage in the event that Chemours is found to have taken any action which brings the program into disrepute.
