The swimming team finished the regular season winning all of their dual meets. Four boys and five girls advanced to the semi-state swim meet in four singles events and four relays. State qualifiers – Ty Boggess (100 freestyle), Max Mays (100 backstroke), Aidan Green (100 breaststroke), Boone Thompson (100 breaststroke), Lily Martin (50 freestyle), Boys 200 Medley and 400 freestyle teams (Ty Boggess, Aidan Green, Max Mays and Boone Thompson) and the Girls 200 freestyle and 400 freestyle teams (Maggie Hollis, Avery Thompson, Sariah Coots, Lyana Coots and Lily Martin).

The boys bowling team finished the regular season with an 8-4 record. The girls bowling team finished 5-5. Both teams competed in the region tournament but did not qualify for state.

The indoor track team will compete in a state qualifying event on February 17. The indoor state track meet is scheduled for March 2 in Louisville.
