- A partnership through LETRS, your local cooperative, and EPSB

- If you currently hold a Rank III or Rank II
- certification
- Have not completed a rank change previously through a CEO program
- Are not currently enrolled in another CEO II Rank Change program such as Bloomboard

#### **CAPSTONE COMPONENT**

#### **CAPSTONE:**

- An on-going process where the participant will be asked to continuously synthesize new learning in Structured Literacy with:
  - Screener, formative and summative assessment data for all students
  - The activities and strategies implemented with the whole class
  - The portfolio documenting the growth of the 6 focus students through the Bridge to Practice work (3 students per year)
  - o classroom, school, district, regional, statewide and national data

Synthesis of this information will be used to identify a problem of practice grounded in literacy and related to the Science of Reading. Using this knowledge, research and experience, participants will present a potential solution to the problem of practice and address how they will lead the effort to transformation toward a more Structured Literacy approach.

- Based on your work with the Bridge to Practices
  - Identify a Problem of Practice
  - Develop an Action Plan to address the need
  - Gather data (benchmark, state, classroom)
  - Organize and Analyze the data
  - Interpret findings and implement instructional plans



#### **CAPSTONE COMPONENT**

#### THE PRESENTATION:

- 15-minute presentation of your Capstone Project
  - May 24 (at the completion of the LETRS professional learning initiative)
  - Presented virtually in a small group setting
  - Feedback will be given using the CEO II LETRS Capstone Rubric

#### **EXITING THE PROGRAM**

- Mentor reviews submissions and capstone
- Completion communicated to Ed COOP
- KEDC, WKEC or NKCES files paperwork with EPSB for rank change
  - Participant completes paperwork as required by EPSB
