
BULLDOG VIRTUAL ACADEMY HHS & <u>HMS</u> BOARD **PRESENTATION 2024**





BVA was a program derived after the pandemic for students who are looking for a non-traditional learning environment.

We have two HS teachers, one MS teacher, two AP's and receive support from many other staff among the two buildings.

BVA OVERALL STRUCTURE

Application Process

Starting in the spring, we share an online application with families and communicate their acceptance.

Custom Edgenuity Courses

All courses have been aligned to our in person course sequence.

Parent Orientation

At the beginning of the school year, we host an orientation night for BVA students and parents to review expectations, devices and Edgenuity.

Weekly Google Meets

Meetings are organized by grade and include a grade check-in, announcements, student questions and socializing.

Deadlines

Each course has a start and end date and students have weekly goals of minutes/units that must be completed.




