**AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION  
COUNTY OF OHIO**

ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION OF THE OHIO COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A KENTUCKY HOUSE BILL (HB) 1 JAIL ARRAIGNMENT EQUIPMENT PHASE II GRANT APPLICATION FOR UP TO \$44,018.00 IN HB 1 PROJECT FUNDS WITH THE DEPARTMENT FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DLG); AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE OHIO COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS WHICH ARE DEEMED NECESSARY BY DLG TO CARRY OUT THIS PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE TO ACT AS THE AUTHORIZED CORRESPONDENT FOR THIS PROJECT.

**WHEREAS**, Ohio County ("County") desires to purchase jail arraignment equipment approved by the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) on behalf of the residents of the County by supporting the HB 1 Project; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recognized that HB 1 monies available to the County for the purposes stated herein, pursuant to 2022 Kentucky General Assembly HB 1 (Budget Bill), impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the County and will require among other things:

- (1) Approval of a satisfactory application transmitted to DLG for approval; and,
- (2) Other obligations of the County in connection with receiving the HB 1 grant of monies for the purposes stated herein;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved this 9th day of April, 2024, by Ohio County Fiscal Court:

That a HB 1 Jail Arraignment Equipment Phase II Grant Application on behalf of the County for HB 1 monies up to \$44,018.00 for Jail Video Arraignment Equipment Phase II Project. Project shall be submitted to DLG; the County shall provide such additional information and furnish such documentation as may be required, and the County Judge/Executive shall act as the authorized correspondent for this Project.
