I. The meeting was called to order at 3:45 pm by Hope Janes.

II. The council reviewed the current agenda. Nicole Hines made the motion to approve the agenda. Angela Rucker seconded the motion. All were in consensus. The council reviewed the February 15, 2024 regular minutes. Angela Rucker made the motion to accept the minutes. Nicole Hines seconded the motion. All were in consensus. No public comment.

III. In old business the following financial statements were reviewed: bank reconciliation reports, general ledger, and the TKS reconciliation reports. Kristin Willett made the motion to accept the financial statements. Nicole Hines seconded the motion. All were in consensus. Hope Janes shared that the committees have not met yet. They will be meeting on April 8th.

IV. Mr. Todd presented information on sports for the middle school level. The following sports were presented as options for 2024-2025 T.K. Stone Middle School team sports and voted on by the council: Boys Soccer, Girls Soccer, Tennis, Track and Softball. Soccer, Track and Softball would be Spring Sports. Tennis would be a Fall Sport. Softball does not currently have the numbers to support a team being formed. The council reached consensus and approved the additional 2024-2025 sports contingent on the approval by the EIS School Board. Coaches for these sports will be interviewed/hired for these newly formed teams following Policies 7.01 and 1.01. Hope Janes then reviewed the Allocations for 2024-2025. The school has been allocated 22 classroom teachers and 30 total certified positions. Hope Janes then presented the 2024-2025 budget. After review, the council decided to change the A/H Dept funding to Chorus and Band. They will have 1000 dollars allocated to split. Arts and Humanities has been moved to share the allotment for Electives. Art will be allocated 500 dollars. Kristin Willett made the motion to accept the budget. Nicole Hines seconded the motion. All were in consensus.
