- b. Staffing Allocations: The staffing allocations for the 2024-2025 school year were discussed for approval. At the current time, half of Amy Truitt's salary is being funded by the general fund. If no additional funding is given, Title 1 money will have to be used to pay the remainder of her salary. That will cause a decrease in support with interventions. Funding includes the current positions of 8 kindergarten teachers with 8 IAs and 4 preschool teachers with 5 preschool IAs. Since ESSR funding will end this year, one of the full-time intervention positions will no longer be available. We were allocated 2 special education teachers and 2 IAs; however the district may be reorganizing special education so that we will only have 1 special education teacher here. Staffing remains the same in all other areas.
