Steve/Kevin,

Good afternoon, I hope this email finds you doing well. After our last discussion on the phone Steve I reached out to Kolpak as well as the architect to see if the heat trace shown under the slab where the walk in goes was necessary. According to Kolpak this serves no purpose and is not needed so we would like to have that removed from the design. Furthermore, when I was on site last week we discussed changing the design of the walk in all together to reduce the price for the owner as well as give them an additional 4" of width space in each compartment. The current design had this box as 3 separate units with s/s filler pieces between each compartment to close it off. We are proposing to change this to a combo box eliminating the 6" of space between each compartment and having the share a common wall. By doing this it reduces the cost significantly as well as giving the owner additional space in each compartment.

I have attached the credit proposal that we can offer to the owner to make this change as well as the revised drawings with a note on them stating that the heat trace is not necessary. My office will follow up tomorrow with the formal excel proposal form that is needed as well but I wanted to get this in front of you now since the floor in that area is being poured next week.
