RE: Prime Date Final Analysis

On February 21, 2011 Gary Lawson ran a final schedule audit and found 43 of our member schools that play girls basketball to be out of compliance with our 40% Prime Date requirement. Based upon his initial audit on the first playing date of November 29, 2010, all but three of these schools (Bath County, Morgan County, and Shawnee) were in compliance with the 40% Prime Date requirement, but due to weather related cancellations, were forced to reschedule some of their games thereby putting them out of compliance. Although Bath County High School and Morgan County High School were not in compliance after the initial schedule audit, they did indeed make adjustments to their schedules after being contacted by Mr. Lawson, but were also forced to reschedule some games due to weather. All of these schools requested and were granted a waiver of the 40 %Prime Date Requirement due to weather related cancellations.

Shawnee High School's home gymnasium was damaged by the scoreboard falling on it during the pre-season. Neither the girls or boys basketball teams were able to play any home games until the floor was repaired on January 18, 2011. As a result, Shawnee High School was also granted a waiver of the 40% Prime Date requirement.
