The School Facilities Construction Commission (SFCC) has made an official offer of assistance to the Trigg County Board of Education. This Offer of Assistance is in the amount of \$20,535.19 annual debt service on bonds to be sold for proposed construction or major renovation of facilities in our District Facility Plan (priority one projects only). The acceptance of this offer requires the encumbering of the fund balances in both the Building Fund and Capital Outlay fund. I recommend the acceptance of the SFCC Offer of Assistance in the amount of \$20,535.19 with the district verifying the Cash Building Fund Balance and the Capital Outlay Fund balance has been transferred to the SFCC escrow accounts, plus interest accumulated on these funds.
