ALGF Subcommittee Share Out–Gary Chapin Facilitation	Maddie Shepard & Alan Young	Alan Young reflected on the day committee members spent with Gary Chapin to learn about how we communicate student learning and how we can change the trajectory. It was well-received and Alan suggested bringing Chapin back in the future as we continue this work. The HS Subcommittee suggested moving to no categories by year 2, and asking that "evidence of learning" be reviewed and updated. Jennifer Cave said that the MS Subcommittee discussed finding language other than "mastery". Allyson Vitato shared that the Elementary Subcommittee discussed early primary and developmental appropriateness. Other things discussed: 1) The danger in using only one category - it would have to be crystal clear as to the intention 2) Keep 2 categories for now, but plan to go to 1 category for year 2 and clearly define it 3) Rollout must be planned with training starting this summer 4) Report card must support changes made 5) Go slow and be prepared so that we do not set up negatives 6) IC must include weights 7) Evidence of learning and growth - types of work need to be clarified 8) Testing should not be the only evidence of growth 9) Preamble to ALGF needs to be amended Alan Young shared the "SPP and ALGF Revisions 22-23 and Beyond" draft language for us to review.
