## Next Steps

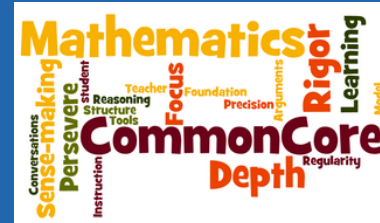
- Reduce visibility and access to all spaces
