## 5. Describe your plans to address interest below:

While our student survey indicates interest in Field Hockey, Bass Fishing, Lacrosse and Wrestling we have several facility and geographic limitations to add additional sports at this time. In May 2018, will will survey students again to confirm their interest in the sports listed. If adequate support for the listed sports is present we will investigate the limitations of competition and facilities. Currently, we have 15 of our athletic teams utilizing off campus facilities due to our geographic restriction. Archery was added this current year into a temporary facility and we must secure a permanent facility for the 2018-2019 year. If wrestling was to be offered it will need to be off campus in a rented facility. We will explore this option if student interests are confirmed.

Currently in regards to Bass Fishing, Lacrosse, and Field hockey we are substantially limited with viable competition teams and sites. Until competitions and schools further expand these offering in our area we do not see adding these sports as viable.

Highlands has had a robust Dance team for many years. Our team has state of the art facilities and is able to compete state wide and nationally. This has been an excellent addition to our sports program.
