The EL Program at NKCES provides direct services and consultation to eight school districts in the northern Kentucky region.

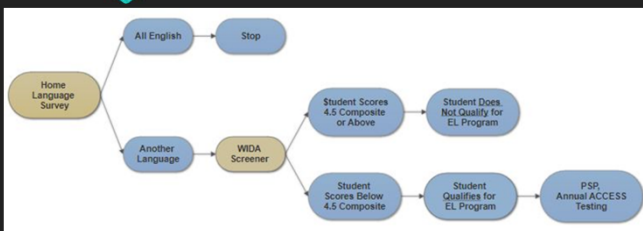
Our goals are:
