

School Council Authority (SBDM) and Responsibility**AUTHORITY**

The council is a ~~statutory~~ policy-making body established by Board policy per KRS 160.345. Outside of a legally called council meeting, no council member, other than the Principal, has decision making or administrative authority conferred by ~~office membership~~ on the council. The Principal is the school's primary and singular administrator and instructional leader.

~~COUNCIL COMMITTEES~~

~~Each school council shall be responsible for formulating its own policies regarding selection of council committees, either standing or ad hoc. The staff of a school shall divide into committees according to their areas of interest or relevance. Each committee shall elect by a majority of the committee, a chair, who shall serve a term of one (1) year. Each committee shall submit its recommendations to the school council for consideration and action.~~

~~All certified personnel shall serve on school committees as needed; this shall be considered part of their assigned responsibilities.~~
