School Council Authority (SBDM)and Responsibility

AUTHORITY

The council is a statutory policy-making body established by Board policy per KRS 160.345. Outside of a legally called council meeting, no council member, other than the Principal, has decision making or administrative authority conferred by officemembership on the council. The Principal is the school's primary and singular administrator and instructional leader.

COUNCIL COMMITTEES

Each school council shall be responsible for formulating its own policies regarding selection of council committees, either standing or ad hoc. The staff of a school shall divide into committees according to their areas of interest or relevance. Each committee shall elect by a majority of the committee, a chair, who shall serve a term of one (1) year. Each committee shall submit its recommendations to the school council for consideration and action.

All certified personnel shall serve on school committees as needed; this shall be considered part of their assigned responsibilities.
