CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

Moral Instruction

TIME AND PLACE

For those students who request moral instruction, the Board authorizes one (1) day each week for up to one (1) hour when students in grades two and three may be excused for moral instruction. Students shall be credited with time spent as if they had been in actual attendance in school.

Said instruction shall not be provided in District facilities.

COST

Moral education shall be given to requesting students without expense to the Board.

COMMUNICATIONS

All communications with parents and students regarding moral instruction shall take place outside the school and shall be conducted by persons not employed by the District.

SUPERVISION

Students shall be supervised to and from the location of the instruction by responsible adults who are not employed by the District.

OTHER PUPILS

Students not taking moral instruction shall remain in school, but shall not receive any educational advantage over children receiving moral instruction.
