

Preschool Education

The Board shall provide a developmentally appropriate preschool education program in compliance with applicable statutes and administrative regulations. This program shall be provided for all resident at-risk four (4) year-olds and all three (3) and four (4) year-old students with disabilities. Tuition-based program options may be offered to resident and nonresident children of District employees who do not otherwise meet eligibility criteria.

Plans for the preschool program shall include transportation and supervision guidelines consistent with the mental and physical characteristics of preschool students. The Principal/designee shall designate another adult to provide back-up assistance when only one (1) employee is responsible for supervising a group of preschool students.
