

FTIS COVID Update September 13, 2021

Field Trips

- Building level administration is evaluating each field trip request to determine approval.
- Considerations include:
 - Proper spacing on bus to accommodate 3 ft between individuals
 - COVID protocol while on trip
 - Purpose of trip

Assemblies

- Principals are also evaluating the need for assemblies at each school.
- Assemblies will be limited while COVID cases are a concern.

Quarantine Numbers as of 9/10/21

Total Number of Positive Cases Since August 18, 2021	44
Total Number of Positive Cases Due to School Exposure	0
Total Number of Quarantine Cases Due to School Exposure	56
Total Number of Quarantine Cases Due to Non-School Exposure	88

Close Contacts

- An individual who is within 6 feet unmasked while indoors for over 15 minutes.
- **Exception:** strategies were in place. In the K-12 indoor classroom setting, the close contact definition excludes students who were at least 3 feet away from an infected student if both students correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time and other K-12 COVID-19 prevention

Procedures following Exposure

- An individual will be identified as a close contact to a positive case.
- Unvaccinated students who are identified as close contacts within a school setting will be instructed to:
 - While experiencing zero symptoms, quarantine for a period of 10 days with the option for early testing to reduce the quarantine to 8 days; OR
 - Participate in the **Test to Stay Program**
- Fully vaccinated individuals with no symptoms do not need to quarantine.

Test to Stay Eligibility

- Must be asymptomatic
- Have been exposed to the positive case at school only
- Be willing to test daily on days 1-5
