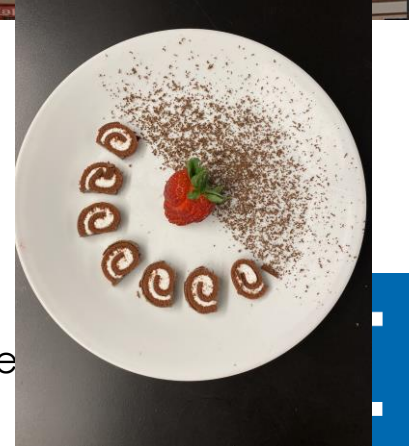

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ServSafe Manager Certification

- The ServSafe Manager Certification or a similar American National Standards Institute certification is required to be a manager in Kentucky
- The certification verifies that a manger has proper knowledge on food safety and all food-borne illnesses in order to properly protect their business
- 90 question exam, must score a 75% or higher to pass
- 1 month preparation for the exam
- Taken in Culinary I and II
