### Safety

- Monthly School Safety Walkthroughs are completed by the assigned staff member at each school.
- Completed the required AED access and location report to KDE. Mr. Atkins submitted the assurances.
- New signs are currently being installed on the campus of Newport Intermediate School/Welcome Center to indicate that pets are not permitted on school grounds, with the exception of service animals. This measure follows a recent school safety visit which identified potential safety concerns related to pets on campus, particularly during the school day when students may be outside for activities such as recess or outdoor instruction (group projects, science experiments, art projects, etc).

### Health Services

#### School-Based Health Center - HealthPoint Family Care

- Opened October 14th. Services are available from the nurse practitioner on Tuesdays and Wednesdays 8 A.M. - 3 P.M. Appointments are scheduled through the school nurse.

#### School Nursing

- All school nurses continue to work diligently on updating school health records. Parents/Guardians have been notified by phone and in writing if their child is not in compliance with the regulations. Immunization compliance reports are due by December 31st each school year.
