Overall, I think we can be pleased in the district, but we have identified a need to focus districtwide on extended response questions. We have had some success in novice reduction, and we now need to focus on apprentice reduction – moving students into novice.

The elementary school is engaged in the winter iReady assessments. The Jr/Sr High students are preparing for midterms.

CSIP/CDIP processes has entered phase 3. The trauma plan, safety report and the needs assessment have been completed. The next benchmark date is January 1, for the CSIP/CDIP submissions as well as the superintendent assurances.

We are fast approaching the mid-year break, which means we are fast approaching what we always consider our intense instructional window. With cooperation of mother nature— which seems to be a little dicey right now— we hope to hit a strong stride going into the spring.
