

Board of Education Resolution

WHEREAS, the people of Marion County passed a local “Nickel” tax with the understanding that those funds would, in part, be used toward improving Lebanon Elementary; and

WHEREAS, the Marion County Board of Education has successfully redistricted its elementary schools as required by the Kentucky Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, members of the public have been clear in their support of both a new Calvary Elementary School and a new Lebanon Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the final cost of the now-constructed Calvary Elementary School was twice that of the original projected cost due to inflation; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated cost of a new Lebanon Elementary exceeds the current funding and bonding capacity available to the district,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Marion County Board of Education humbly requests that the Kentucky Legislature allocate within its budget \$10 million to Marion County Public Schools for the construction of a new Lebanon Elementary School.
