Creekside Elementary School is located in the community of Sonora, KY and serves students PreK-5th grade with a total enrollment of 420 K-5. Students who attend Creekside live in the rural areas of Upton, Sonora, Glendale, and Southern Elizabethtown. 13% of the student population are in a minority group, and 56% qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch. Our school began an AgSTREAM initiative in late 2021, and we have expanded our program to include an immersive outdoor and indoor agriculture curriculum for all students K-5. Additionally, STEM classes are offered to all K-5 students. Construction on a large Ford plan has begun within our school's geographic boundaries, and we are enrolling new students regularly. Explosive growth in population within our area is expected to begin anytime. We have the most consistent staff this year than we have had in 6 years.

using the Studer Pillars of Success. The local community plays a huge role in Creekside's success, and we are continuously striving to build our partnerships with parents through new and varied engagement activities.
