North Hardin High School (NHHS) serves 1569 students in grades 9 through 12. The school is located in Radcliff, Ky and is situated next to Fort Knox Military Base. Our school serves a diverse community at the north end of Hardin County, KY. Our school has multiple students who have scored over 30 on the ACT, multiple students who have been accepted into and selected for the Governor's School for the Arts and Governor's Scholars Program along with a senior class that has earned over 6 million dollars in scholarships to attend college or technical schools upon graduation.

We offer various pathways in coordination with the districts Early College and Career Center (EC-3) to allow students to earn industry certifications in a field of study they wish to pursue after graduation or to earn college credit through enrollment in dual credit or Advanced Placement courses.

Notable Achievements

North Hardin High School students earn 30 points or higher on the ACT. Our students earn multiple scholarships prior to graduation. Many of our students are named to district, regional and state offices in their Career and Technical Service Organizations, earn recognition in Kentucky Music Educators Association competitions, etc. Over 80 percent of our students are career or college ready by the time they graduate. Our school boasts of alumni who are CEOs of Fortune 500 companies; some of have earned the opportunity to play college and professional sports; many serve the community as local politicians and citizens who work to benefit our local and surrounding communities.
