Dear Judge French:

Biennial inspections of all county bridge structures, (structures 20 feet or greater in length), located in Gallatin County, were completed in April 2011. Enclosed are copies of our inspection reports for these structures, a listing of the condition rating guidelines used for the structure evaluation, a posting compliance form, suggested work orders, and a bridge location map.

The following is a list of all bridges that require posting (weight limits below 18 ton) and the posting status of each:
