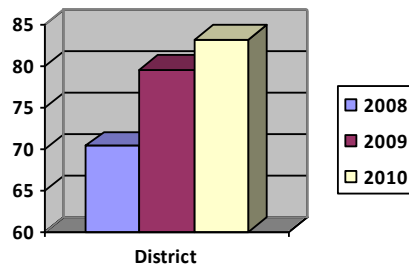


## Henderson County Schools 2009-10 Graduation Data released

Graduation data for the class of 2009-10 has been released.

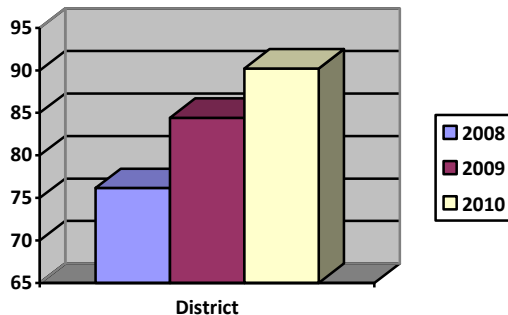
For NCLB purposes:

The Adjusted KY rate (takes into account those students who received certificates of completion and took more than four [4] years to graduate):

Pertaining to the NCLB data:

Some things that stand out in the data:

- The district exceeded the state's NCLB goal of 82.32%.
- The district was 6.49% above the state NCLB average of 76.68%.
- Our district's graduation rates have continued to increase over the past 3 years. The 2010 rate is 12.86% above the 2008 rate.
- Female grad rates have increased 15.31% in 3 years – up to 87.5%.
- Male grad rates have increased 10.71% in 3 years – up to 79.19%
- African American grad rates have increased 14.37% in 3 years – up to 82.46%.
- White grad rates have increased 12.29% in 3 years – up to 82.38%.

Some things that stand out in the adjusted Kentucky data:

- The district was 9.72% above the state's adjusted average of 80.5%.
- Our district's graduation rates have continued to increase over the past 3 years. The 2010 rate is 14% above the 2008 rate.
- Female grad rates have increased 17% in 3 years – up to 95.22%.
- Male grad rates have increased 11% in 3 years – up to 85.62%
- African American grad rates have increased 19% in 3 years – up to 92.98%.
- White grad rates have increased 13% in 3 years – up to 89.22%.
