Pre-trip preparatory activities:

At the state convention your child will have the opportunity to compete in the following: Individual talent, Group talent, Essay, On site poetry, Poster, Speech, Academic areas of competition: Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, Science, Spelling, Quiz Bowl, Arts: Photography, Sketching, Water color, Oil or acrylic painting, Sculpture, Crafts: Counted/stamped cross-stitch, Crochet/knitting, Wood working, Needlepoint/embroidery, Decorated wreath, Jewelry hand made. More information will be given to your child related to the state convention in the upcoming months. Attendance at the state convention will also be pending on board approval.
- 3) The National Beta Convention will be held in North Carolina, July 2012. If we have students who qualify at the state convention we will then discuss the possibility of attending the national convention and fundraising opportunities to help offset the cost of the trip.
