On behalf of the members of the Kentucky School Boards Association, we are delighted to invite your district to nominate students in the Class of 2012 for the inaugural awarding of KSBA's First Degree College Scholarship.

The KSBA Board of Directors established this scholarship in support of Kentucky's efforts to increase the college and career readiness of our high school graduates. To that end, KSBA will award two \$2,500 scholarships to one male and one female student who upon graduation would become the first members of their immediate families to earn a post-secondary degree.

This one-year, nonrenewable scholarship has two eligibility criteria:

- a) Students who are nominated must reside in a household in which neither their parents, guardians or siblings have earned a college degree; and
- b) Nominated students must have attained a score of at least 20 in reading on the ACT during their junior or senior year at the time of nomination.

We invite all Kentucky public school boards and their high schools to submit the attached nomination form for up to two students, one male, one female. The completed form is to be signed by the high school guidance counselor and the board chairperson.

Nominations must be received no later than Nov. 30 to:

The KSBA Board of Directors will select the two scholarship honorees at its December quarterly meeting by means of a lottery draw. Nominated students will be notified in December and recognized at the 76<sup>th</sup> KSBA Annual Conference in Louisville on Feb. 4, 2012.

KSBA will make payment of the \$2,500 scholarship directly to the college of enrollment of each selected student upon receipt of a copy of the letter confirming enrollment acceptance.
