

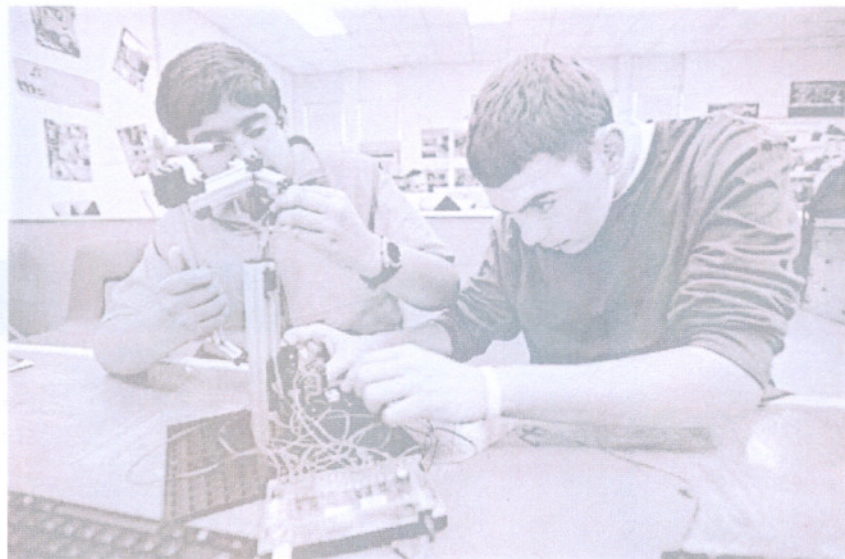
EXPECTATIONS UP, RESOURCES DOWN

As a state, we've committed to much higher expectations, but state funding per student has declined in program after program.

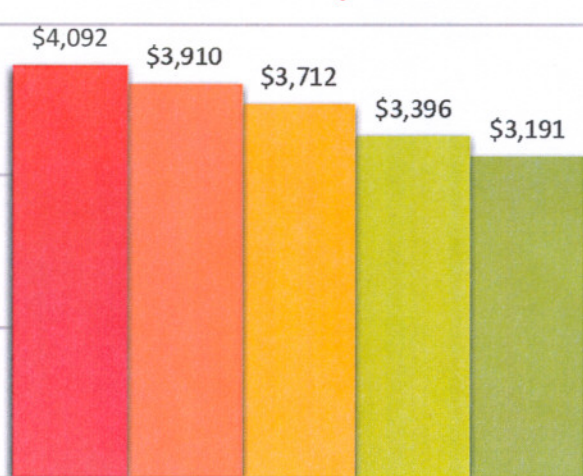
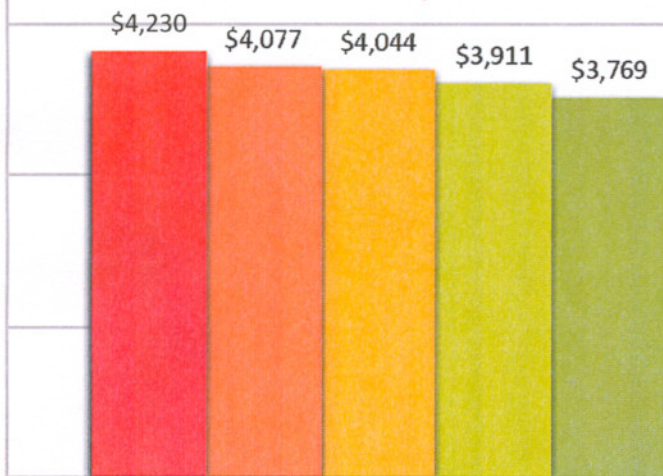
It's time to invest in our children, providing the vital financial support required to meet our bold new goals.

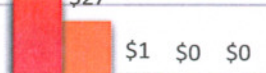
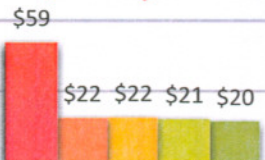
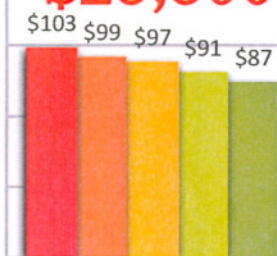
