

Tobacco

Students shall not be permitted to use or possess any tobacco_-product or nicotine product (i.e. electronic cigarette, nicotine gum, nicotine patch or other similar product) on property owned or operated by the Board, inside Board-owned vehicles, on the way to and from school, or during school-sponsored trips and activities.

Students with a doctor's order or prescription shall provide the school with a copy to be kept on file.

Students who violate these prohibitions while under the supervision of the school shall be subject to penalties set forth in the local code of acceptable behavior and discipline.
