Effective: June 13, 1968



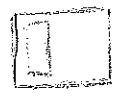
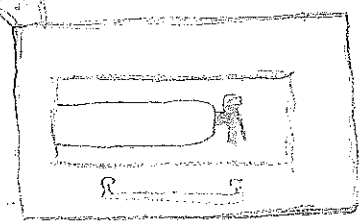
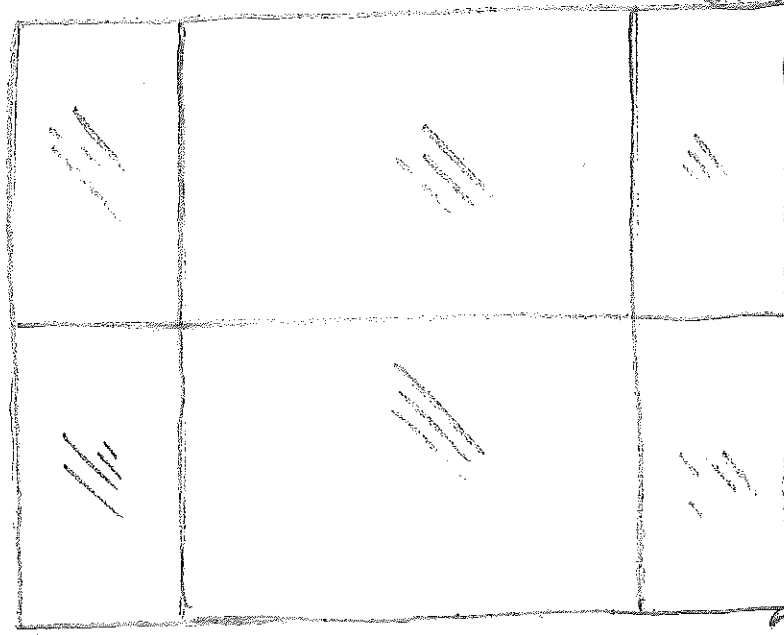
State Horse, Thoroughbred

(the tree will wrap around to the other side)



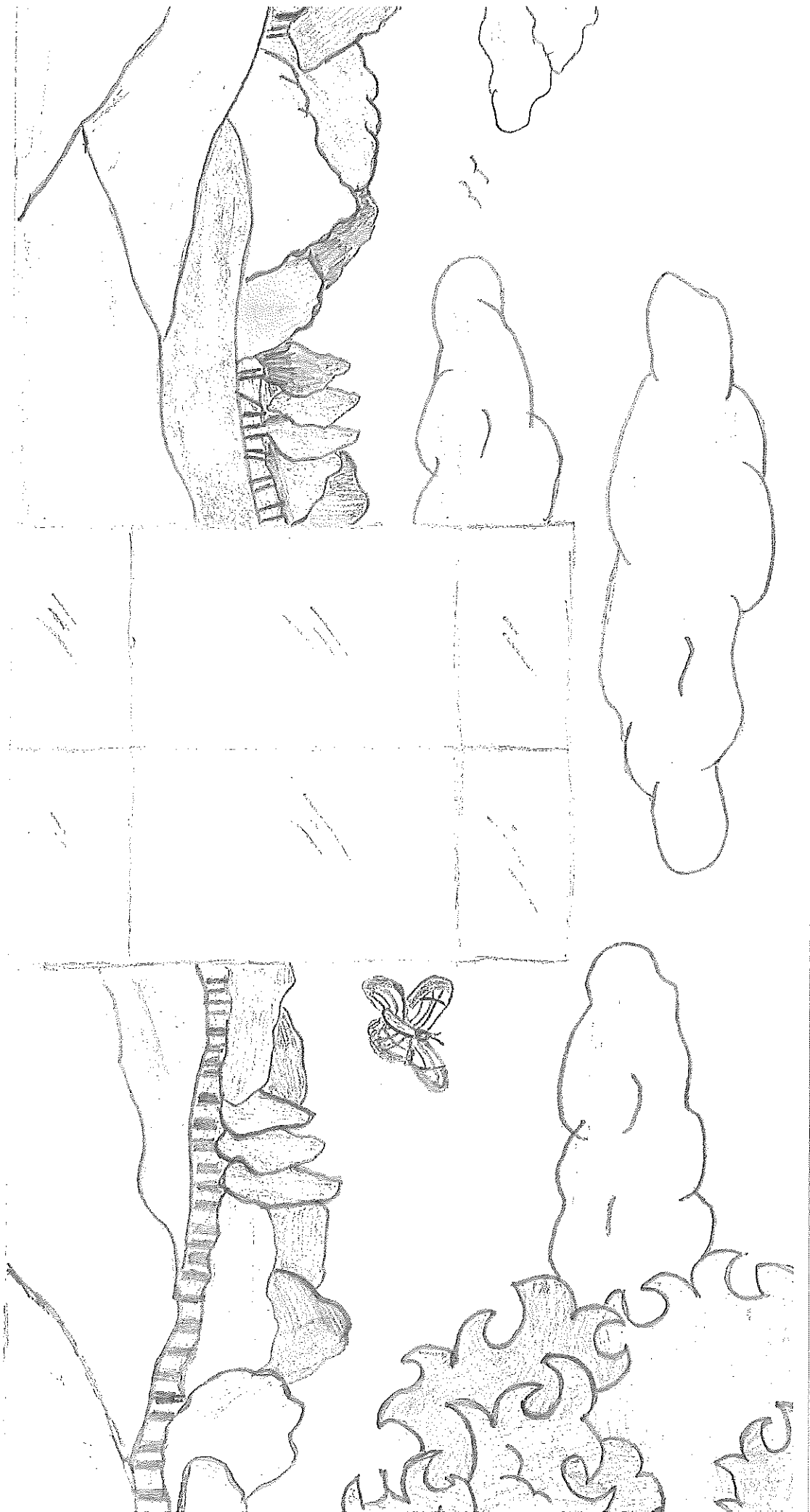
