This event is to educate the community on all the emergency services available to their community and allows the community to meet all the emergency responders that respond when they are needed. This event includes a Waterball Challenge. The Waterball Challenge involves a firemen competition that has a huge ball attached to a cable which is stretched across the parking lot. The firemen teams spray water at the ball with a fire hose and the team that keeps the ball on the opposite team's side the longest, in a timed period, is the winning team. Many teams compete, but only one team finishes first. Trophies are given to the winners.
